

The Economic Activity of Dance in New York City


Summary

Non-profit dance companies and presenters in New York City generate...

- Nearly a half a billion (\$415.72 million) of local economic activity annually
- Greater than **one million** paid attendances

The economic activity of dance in New York City generates...

- Organizational spending of \$121.0 million
- Audience spending of \$135.4 million
- \$182.2 million in labor income
- 4,311 full-time equivalent jobs
- **1,022,073** paid performance attendance



Jobs

New York City dance organizations directly employ...

- **1,200** full-time employees
- 800 part-time employees
- **630** contract employees
- **8,600** volunteers at these organizations donate close to **40,000** hours of service yearly

These organizations spend more than \$80 million in employment annually

Attendance


New York City's dance organizations perform worldwide before more than two million patrons each year...

- 1,637,000 patrons attend ticketed performances
- **268,000** patrons participate in school performances/programs
- Free performances attract 40,000 patrons
- 116,000 patrons are involved in lecture/demonstrations, residencies and other activities
- 60% of all attendance takes place in New York City
- New York City audiences are drawn from the 5 boroughs (62.6%), the metropolitan region (25.9%) and visitors from outside the area (11.5%)
- The city's dance companies engage **824,000** patrons through programs on tour (domestic and international)

Patron Spending

Dance audiences in NYC generate more than \$135 million in direct economic activity annually...

- \$68.1 million on tickets
- \$29.1 million on food
- \$26 million on travel
- \$6.1 million on lodging
- \$11.4 million on shopping/merchandise
- \$0.9 million on child care
- The average patron spends almost **\$70** on activities associated with attendance at New York City dance performances *beyond* the price of admission...
