Each New Yorker counted represents \$3,000 in federal funding for our city each year and helps ensure adequate representation in Congress. An accurate population count is critical! Please go to [my2020census.gov](#) to answer 10 short questions before the deadline of September 30. Responses are private and no questions are asked about citizenship or immigration status. TIP: if you have an incentive to offer those who complete the census on the spot (ie. free tickets, free membership), it makes for a stronger pitch and response rate!
