On Tuesday, February 14, Dance/NYC and its Junior Committee will join the New York City Arts Coalition and sister arts groups statewide for Arts Day in Albany.

This is an important opportunity for the City's dance community–artists and managers–to meet our representatives and help make the case for State funding. The 2012-2013 executive budget released last week recommends \$37.7million in total funding for the New York State Council on the Arts (NYSCA), a \$1.2 million decrease from the budget for 2011-2012.
