The Children's and Young Dancer's Program provides year-round and summer classes from ages two through high school; the Trainee Division is subdivided into classical ballet, contemporary ballet, and jazz and contemporary full-time, year-round programs; and the Adult Program offers drop-in classes and workshops seven days a week for students of all abilities. Graduates of the School have gone on to dance for major classical ballet companies, as well as for numerous modern and contemporary companies, both in the United States and abroad.
