Salary: Stipend of \$100/week

Reporting: The intern would report directly to Director, and work with Dance/NYC operations manager, media contractor, program intern, advisors and Junior Committee to create synergies in messaging.

Applicants should have a demonstrated track record of successful social media initiatives, with a preferred focus on industry-wide, service organization and/or dance projects. Preference will be given to candidates with sizeable "friends" and "followers."
