Here is a glimpse of what Dante has in mind for the workshop!
"I'm interested in creating a 5 day process where we investigate movement quality, dynamic variance, weight, focus, and performance presence; resulting in a ten minute work that will be presented at The Dance Gallery Festival. We will aim to push ourselves to discover new things about our moving bodies through improvisation, release technique, dynamic partnering, and challenging phrase material. "
