What is The Growth Art Project?

ARTLAB OH and SUNPROJECT co-present "The Growth Art Project (TGAP)," a contemporary dance series featuring talented emerging international choreographers and performers living and working in the New York area.

The Growth Art Project 2014 (TGAP) has been produced by 'In Kyung Oh,' founder of "ArtLab OH," and created by artistic director 'Sun-ae Hwang' of "SUNPROJECT." The project will select rising contemporary dance teams and will showcase their outstanding pieces. Works by "SUNPROJECT," as well as other up-and-coming and established dance companies, will be performed.
