The program includes a curriculum that is developed by the faculty who teach these courses. Teachers would learn the curriculum (since he/she is being hired after the curriculum has been developed), which they would supplement with their own material and exercises.

Moving Wheels & Heels, is an adaptive dance class program for children and adults of all abilities - stand up and sit down. Participants learn dance technique and experience improvisation and movement activities in a safe, supportive atmosphere to improve range of motion, gain strength and endurance, express their own creativity, and make friends.
