3-Year Fellowship in Arts Management Strategy – DeVos Institute of Arts Management at the University of Maryland

Compensation: Air and ground transportation to DC, lodging, and per diem living expenses during fellowship.

The DeVos Institute's Fellowship program provides intensive training in arts and cultural management, artistic planning, marketing, fundraising, evaluation, and finance for mid-career arts managers over a three year period. Applications are due December 15, 2015.

The program is offered free of charge to arts managers from across the United States and around the world through a competitive application process. Fellows attend a four-week residency in Washington, D.C. each summer for three consecutive years and receive ongoing personalized mentoring, both during and between the month-long residencies. Since 2001, the Fellowship has served nearly 200 managers from 53 countries.
