We work with inner city youth teenagers who may have pending legal matters or who do not have any pending legal matters, but are steered along the wrong path. Our sole purpose is to divert and supervise at risk youth from a life of crime and incarceration by instilling in them the understanding and acceptance of their moral responsibilities for the consequences of their actions.

The Andrew Glover Youth Program is currently looking for volunteers that can conduct workshops one day out of the week (Mondays – Fridays) between the hours of 5pm – 6pm for various weeks consisting of dancing lessons that can take place throughout an extended period of time.
