Serve as central clearing point for all departmental ticketing needs at Ailey, monitor departmental seat holds and releases & maintain accurate records of department house seats for each performance

Implement policies and procedures for Ticket Managers' office and management & operation of Ailey's internal ticketing process. Other duties as assigned

The position commences in November and applicants will be required to works five days a week in November (off Thurs Nov 23 & Fri Nov 24 for Thanksgiving) and six days a week (off Mondays) during Ailey's City Center season which runs from Nov 30 to Dec 31. You must be able to work Christmas Day and New Year's Eve.
