What Does Your Performance Fee Cover?

-Two performances of your piece in a theater in front of a live audience.

- Marketing materials & exposure: performance postcards, social media features, & publicity on ads and our website.
- Professional stage lighting by our lighting designer (1 lighting look that you design along with our lighting designer)
- Professional photographs and HD video footage of your piece in performance (this is a high priority for us).

If selected, your work will be presented in 1 evening performance and 1 matinee performance. Each performance will include an usher, stage manager, dressing rooms for the dancers, snacks & drinks for your dancers (included) and refreshments available for purchase for the audience.

Participation Requirements

- Proposed work must be a maximum of 12 minutes (longer pieces will not be accepted).
- You must be available and in New York City for the performance weekend, which is Friday September 29th through Sunday October 1st, 2017.
- You must be available and in New York City for one 30 minute technical and dress rehearsal slot with our lighting designer at Access Theater on either Friday 9/29 between the times of 10:00AM and 4:00PM or on Saturday 9/30 between the times of 9:00AM and 12:00PM.
- You must pay the non-refundable application processing fee of \$15, and once accepted, the performance fee of \$235 (your submitted application acts as your agreement of participation).
- You must submit your application + app fee by no later than Monday August 28th at 11:59PM (EST).
