The Joyce Theater Foundation's mission is to serve and support the art of dance and choreography, to promote the richness and variety of the art form in its fullest expression, and to advance the public interest in, and appreciation of, dance and the allied arts of music, design, and theater.

Integral to shaping The Joyce Theater's local and international acclaim, the director of programming works with the executive director to curate and manage the artistic programming at The Joyce Theater. He/she travels extensively to identify the best companies for The Joyce's stage, and with the executive director, carefully constructs each Joyce season by selecting dance companies to balance dance genres, styles, and countries of origin.
