

The EMERGING CHOREOGRAPHER SERIES, presented in partnership with LaGuardia Performing Arts Center-CUNY, is a one-of-a-kind FREE choreography mentorship program that offers 50+ hours of rehearsal space, professional consultations, peer and panelist feedback, and 2 professionally produced performances at LaGuardia Performing Arts Center. Selected participants will receive space grants, logistical support, marketing and advertising material, professional lighting and technical support, and the tools to create, develop and perform a new finished work. Participants will work directly with MNE's artistic director Nicola lervasi (Martha Graham Dance Ensemble), and in-house director Kevin Albert (Boston Conservatory) and fellow participants in order to expand their choreographic ideas, and broaden their professional network and understanding of the industry. Their works will premiere at LaGuardia Performing Arts Center on Feb. 25 & 26, 2019.

- > 8-week rehearsals: January 3 Feb 23, 2019
- > 2 performances at LPAC: Feb. 25 & 26, 2019
- > Weekly meetings with MNE's directors and fellow choreographers
- > UP TO 50 HOURS of FREE rehearsal space

- > Stipend to cover basic expenses (dancers, costumes, props etc)
- > 1 informal showing with panel of professionals for feedback and advice
- > One-on-One mentorship with a professional of choice
