Big Dance Theater is looking for volunteers to help during the company's run of Antigonick at Abrons Arts Center this November. Antigonick is a "pop-up play under construction" of Anne Carson's one-act, radical-feminist take on Sophocles' Antigone.

Antigonick runs 30 minutes and will be performed twice each evening, with a party/ Dionysian Libation between the two shows.

Performances will take place at Abrons Arts Center (466 Grand St.) November 13 - 17.

Requirements:

Volunteers will be in costume (Greek togas) and will be asked to serve refreshments and food to patrons.

Pre-pour of drinks will be necessary, as well as some cleaning during the partyonly.

Nov 14 – Nov 17 7pm – Performance #1 7:45 – 8:30pm – Dionysian Libation 8:30 – Performance #2

We estimate a total of 1.5 hours/day with a 7pm call for volunteers. You will be free to leave at 8:30pm.

Each volunteer will receive one ticket for the show.

The company recently celebrated their 25th Anniversary at the Kitchen, performed at BAM/Harvey, in Berlin, and was honored by PS122.
