ABOUT THE POSITION

Teaching Artists supervise and teach their discipline to a group of twenty students incorporating literacy in the widest sense of the word.

We are looking for versatile and flexible teachers who are open to frequent feedback on their classroom management and lesson plans, and who are excited to be part of a creative team. Popular art forms with our youth are: Visual Arts, Dance/Movement, Theater and Music. The ideal candidate will possess excellent classroom management. Strong, sensitive and professional communication skills are a must as well as a good sense of personal and professional boundaries. Teaching Artists must have a culturally sensitive approach to working with diverse populations. Applicants should have experience working with youth.

Supervise maintenance of a current portfolio for every student assigned to teacher

Participate in agency wide events

Generate and collaborate on a wide range of community projects and other special projects as needed

Attend meetings and trainings as assigned

Supervise and/or provide first aid/CPR, file accident/illness reports

Complete any other duties assigned by Supervisor(s)
