Responsibilities

- Adminstrate the Open School Program including conducting daily interactions with faculty and musicians, orienting and welcoming newly hired teachers and musicians, scheduling and substituting teachers and musicians, implementing schedule changes, and changing studio assignments.
- Maintain the Center's general day-to-day operations such as answering and redirecting phone calls, answering general email inquiries, collecting workshops and other online registrations, providing information to costumers, faculty, musicians, and staff.
- Coordinate group visits and studio rentals.

- Update the financial department on all new hires and all financial transactions related to the Open Class Program, Groups, and Rentals.

- Extensive knowledge of dance practices and dance technique for multiple genres and ages.

- Detail-oriented, highly organized, motivated, and time-efficient, capable of working in a fast-paced work environment that requires multitasking.
