You must be 17-25 years old and available to photograph on-site both days of the workshop, May 13 + 14

JOB DETAILS:

No application fee

In exchange for your time you will receive an honorarium of \$200

All images are expected shared one week following the workshop. There is no expectation for final images to be edited or pre-selected. No transportation, room and board, or equipment will be provided.

The application opens on February 15 and closes on March 18. We will notify you by April 2 if you are selected for this position!
