Currently, as an independent dance artist, I am looking for a few dancers for two exciting performance opportunities. The first performance will be on Friday, August 8th which dancers will perform an excerpt of a preexisting work titled *1692*. The second performance will be on Sunday, September 21st which dancers will participate in the process of a new work titled *[UN] bound*.

Rehearsals will be based on cast and choreographer availability and will occur about once a week in NYC for the summer and into early September depending on which performance a dancer is in. All dancers may not be needed at all rehearsals. Tech rehearsal is yet to be determined but all dancers will be notified when it is received.
