

Ballaro Bridge is the Training & Development Program of NYC-based Ballaro Dance. Ballaro Bridge dancers will gain professional experience while engaging with a supportive community. This 15-week Training Program runs from March 1-June 13 including:

- + Weekly class & rehearsals with the Company (5-8 hrs./weekly: must be available Wednesdays 10am-2pm and Thursdays 5pm-9pm),
- + Weekly mentoring with Artistic Director, Marisa f. Ballaro (sessions held in-person or on Zoom; flexible schedule based on Ballaro Bridge dancer availability),
- + Matching with a Company dancer for support and guidance throughout the program,
- + Being part of an innovative creative process with collaborators (musicians, filmmakers, photographers, designers...)
- + Attending regular social meet-ups and developing relationships with the Company and its community.

- + Dancers relocating to NYC,
- + Dancers looking for: professional experience, a supportive community, mentoring, development of technical skills, engagement in a creative process.
