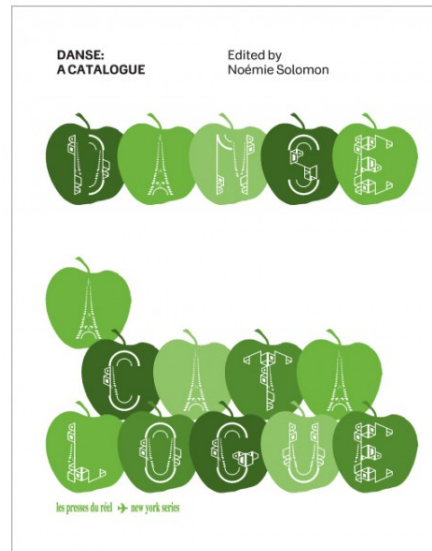
DANSE: A Catalogue - Book Launch Event
