

Audiences will be submerged inside Drexciya Redux: An Afrofuturist Cabaret in the 3rd floor studio transformed into a digitally immersive experience of projection mapping and sound design, inspired by the mythological realm of Drexciya through interdisciplinary performances and queer interruptions by an intergenerational contingent of Black artists activating the possibility of a new world.

"Drexciya" was the name of a pioneering Detroit techno duo, the late James Stinson (1969 – 2002) and Gerald Donald, who created a speculative origin myth about an underwater population of aquatic-humanoids in the Atlantic Ocean populated by the offspring of pregnant African women cast overboard from slave ships along the Middle Passage. As electronic musicians they created the mythology by subverting the horrors of the Trans-Atlantic Slave trade into an imagined sea of potentiality – loosely based on seminal text by Paul Gilroy, The Black Atlantic: Modernity and Double Consciousness (1993), according to the renowned Afrofuturist scholar Kodwo Eshun and expanded on in the text Deep Sea Dwellers: Drexciya and the Sonic Third Space by scholar/artist Nettrice Gaskins.
