Excessive Realness is a five-day dance intensive spanning Wednesday June 16th to Sunday June 20th, 2021. This year, it will take place virtually, in partnership with Dance Place in Washington, DC. On the night of Saturday June 30th, there will be a free performance, entitled The SPILL, whereby the artists of Excessive Realness will perform upcoming dance and performance works.
