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The Taylor School is the premier training ground for modern dance technique in the Taylor style. The Taylor Master Class Series, offered only a few times a year, provides an ideal setting for a more in-depth study of Taylor style and repertory. Taught by distinguished Taylor dancers, this series of two-hour workshops, from 10am to 12pm, encourages students to expand their technical and stylistic levels of proficiency, while exploring their individual voices as performing artists.

ERAN BUGGE is from Oviedo, Florida where she began her dance training at the Orlando Ballet School. She went on to study at the Hartt School of the University of Hartford under the direction of Peggy Lyman, graduating Summa Cum Laude with a B.F.A. in ballet pedagogy in 2005. She attended The Taylor School and the 2004 and 2005 Taylor Summer Intensives. Ms. Bugge has performed in works by Amy Marshall, Katie Stevinson-Nollet and Jean Grand-Maitre. She was also a member of Full Force Dance Theatre and the Adam Miller Dance Project. She joined the Paul Taylor Dance Company in Fall 2005.
