Children will stomp at the Savoy, salute the Harlem Hellfighters, cheer for Joe Louis, and shuffle along at the Hoofers Club. Joining the NDI musicians in the orchestra this year will be students and faculty from the Jazz at Lincoln Center Youth Programs. The event will be performed for audiences 4,600 strong, including 1,600 public school children from NDI's In-School Program who will attend free of charge.
