The Dance Historian Is In: Kevin Winkler on Tommy Tune

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In this month's Dance Historian Is In, Kevin Winkler, the author of *Everything is Choreography: The Musical Theater of Tommy Tune*, utilizes film clips and photographs from the Library for the Performing Arts's collections to celebrate the artistry behind *Grand Hotel*, *My One and Only*, *Nine*, *The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas*, *The Will Rogers Follies*, and other Broadway hits. Tommy Tune, the last in a grand lineage led by Jerome Robbins, Bob Fosse, Gower Champion, and Michael Bennett, took the tradition of complete musical staging by a director-choreographer into a new era defined by technology and spectacle, while providing a link to a new generation of choreographers-turned-directors. Tune's acclaimed performing career will also be explored, as well as the wide-ranging dance influences that have helped shape his unique theatrical vision.
