Tips for Submitting Your Application

- Prepare all of your materials in advance. Dance/NYC estimates applicants may need approximately 5-10 hours to complete their application if they already have work samples available.
- Read the technical assistance offerings outlined below.
- Review all materials provided thoroughly before reaching out to the Dance/NYC team with additional questions. Often your question is answered within!

When you have joined the meeting, it is suggested that you use a headset or earphones with a microphone to avoid feedback. When you are not speaking, mute yourself until ready to speak.

Virtual Technical Assistance Sessions

To assist prospective applicants, Dance/NYC will be holding virtual one-on-one technical assistance sessions via Zoom or by phone. Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Applicants will be able to register for:

One (1) 20-minute session to receive one-on-one support, including but not limited to answering questions about eligibility, required materials, etc. Please register for only one session, at least two (2) business days in advance.
