On July 20, 2022 Dance/NYC launched the <u>Dance Industry Census</u>, which is the first comprehensive research study that aims to better understand the size, makeup, health and state of the dance ecosystem in the metropolitan New York City area in order to address economic inequities in the field and ensure that all dance workers are recognized and represented. Data will be analyzed by Dance/NYC and presented in aggregate form in Dance/NYC's *State of NYC Dance* research report, to be published in winter 2023.
