Over the course of 45 minutes, we take the viewer on a journey through time, capturing along the way important cultural elements of freestyle, play, ritual, lineage, and community. *Journey Into House* is dedicated to friend, mentor, and legendary house dancer-- the late Marjory Smarth, who was a warrior in life, a pioneer in dance, and who touched many lives around the world while spreading her message: "Live True, Dance Free". Marjory passed away on February 12, 2015 after a long battle with cancer. On what would have been her 47th birthday, we celebrate her life and her legacy.
