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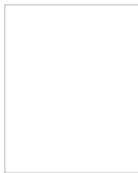

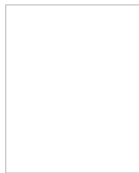

Since our founding in 2007, Dance/NYC's Junior Committee has served as a liaison for New York's emerging dance professionals. The original committee meet quarterly and functioned strictly as an advisory committee for Dance/NYC.
