The goals of iLAB are:

- 1) To invigorate and re-imagine relationships between the public and the urban environment through kinetic experience.
- 2) To engage artists and practitioners across the disciplines ofdance, art, and the ecology of physical interrelationships such thatwe create and investigate innovative approaches to science, infrastructure, urbanisms, and architecture within a performative context.
- 3) To support the development of process in engagement over productsuch that process is itself a productforartistic and public action.

Each year iLAB provides collaborator teams with support including astipend, resources to document the residency, mechanismsfordisseminating their research in the science and art communities, andmentoring throughout the process.

The first round letter of inquiry is due on November 20, 2012. Please note that confirmed collaborators ar**aot**necessary for submitting a LOI for review.
