In addition to interns' primary responsibilities, they will also work on digitizing and organizing archival materials and assist with fundraising, marketing, production, or administrative responsibilities when needed.

In fall 2014, Dancing in the Streets established a long-term partnership with the not-for-profit South Bronx Overall Economic Development Corporation (SoBRO) through which the two organizations are developing initiatives that will use the arts as a catalyst for developing a safe, vibrant, and economically sound South Bronx that serves community needs and reflects and fosters the distinct character and cultural history of the South Bronx.
