REGARDING FEES

\$25 application fee per piece submitted. Piece submitted must be the piece you intend to perform.

If your piece is selected: \$60 membership fee: All choreographers who are chosen to perform their work in the Festival must become current members of the American Dance Guild (\$60/individual). However, you are not required to be a member to apply. Non-members are encouraged to apply. You may join or renew your membership by sending in a check (payable to American Dance Guild) with your festival application OR online through the website www.americandanceguild.org.

\$60 production fee: Once selected, choreographers will be asked to pay a \$60 production fee.

Fee for video and photo to be determined later.

The American Dance Guild, an artist-member run organization, has served the dance field in many capacities since its inception in 1956, including publications, conferences & festivals. The Annual Festival brings together artists from across the nation and around the world.
