APPLICATION PROCESS:

STEP 1 - Pay the \$25 application fee via PayPal. Note that one application fee is required for each application you submit. Choreographers can apply with as many works for Top Floor, and projects for Site Specific as they want.

STEP 2 - Complete the application form in reference to the program you want to apply, TopFloor or All Over Westbeth. Please include a link to a video sample via online source (such as Youtube or Vimeo). Work Samples must be at least 3 continuous minutes in length and be of the proposed work. Minimal cuts/edits are preferred, and rehearsal video of the proposed work is acceptable. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.
