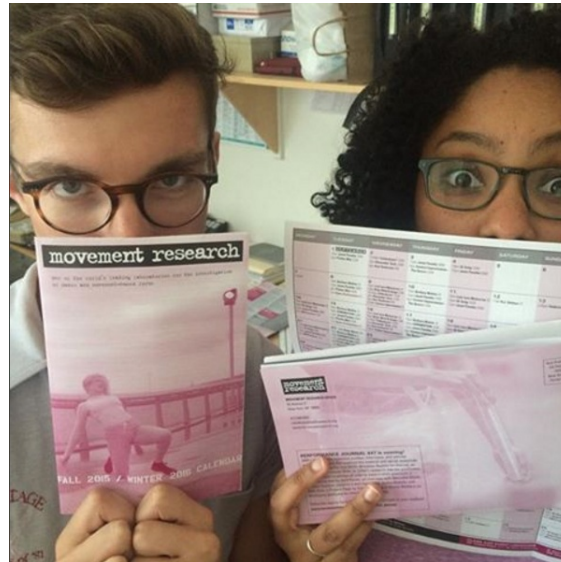

Movement Research offers internship opportunities to dancers of all levels, ages 18 and up. We are currently hiring for office internship positions to start in Spring or Summer, with a 6-month duration and the opportunity to extend. For a 10-hour commitment per week, Movement Research provides interns with free access to most Movement Research classes as well as an occasional workshop or MELT intensive. A limited number of Summer 2016 Internship positions are also available (2-3 months in duration, 15 hours/week).

Performance Journal Archives and Subscriptions Intern
