She has created a singular modern dance training technique and Giordano Alignment, which she teaches as a faculty member at Broadway Dance Center, the Joffrey Ballet School Jazz & Contemporary Intensives and internationally. She is the founder and instructor of an outreach program in New York public school system and is the Salon Series Curator for MCGD.
