RESPONSIBILITIES

Implement and oversee a comprehensive fundraising plan that includes, but is not limited to, the annual giving, campaign, corporate and foundation support, program support, and annual Gala, to meet institutional needs

Create and execute strategies for the identification, cultivation, solicitation, and stewardship of current and new donors, including individuals, corporations, foundations, and government entities

As the Company's lead front-line fundraiser, solicit targeted requests for annual giving and for The Campaign for RIOULT Dance Center Oversee the day-to-day operations and management of the Campaign that includes, but is not limited to, portfolio management, preparation of customized briefing and solicitation materials, oversight of timely donor acknowledgements and stewardship, and maintenance of a list of funded recognition opportunities and available programmatic funding opportunities

Build the annual Development Department budget

Manage and communicate regularly with Board and Chairman's Council members, Development Committee, and staff, and guide them towards greater involvement in fundraising

Facilitate special events that include, but are not limited to, annual Gala, campaign cultivation, and regional cultivation to advance fundraising goals

Oversee the Development Assistant

Work collaboratively with the Executive Director to achieve organizational and fundraising goals
