Founded in 1994, RIOULT Dance NY fast became an established name in modern dance with a reputation for presenting the sensual, articulate, and exquisitely musical works of Pascal Rioult. The New York City-based dance company presents an annual New York season, tours nationally and internationally, conducts extensive in-school arts education and community outreach programs, and offers dance training to the public through classes, workshops, and intensives.

Initially operating from Pascal Rioult & Joyce Herring's New York City apartment, the organization has grown tremendously over the last two decades. To date, Pascal Rioult has created over 45 dances premiering at least one new work every year, presented 23 New York Seasons, toured Europe and North America and has employed over 30 dancers. Prior to RIOULT Dance NY's establishment in 1994, the Company's legacy began evolving through the dancing careers of Pascal Rioult and Joyce Herring. Pascal Rioult had the privilege of working with May O'Donnell and Paul Sanasardo before dancing as a principal for the Martha Graham Dance Company. His roots in American modern dance, paired with those of Joyce Herring, allowed the husband-and-wife team to continue the legacy of the art form in their own right over the next twenty years, and now beyond.
