Movement Research is hiring an experienced Development Manager to head its Development Department. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled, and reviewed upon receipt. Application deadline is Monday February 11, 2019 at midnight.

The Development position is part-time hourly at 20–25 hours/week. Hourly compensation rate is commensurate with experience. As part of the compensation package, employee also receives the benefit of free access to Movement Research classes and selected workshops. Employee contribution 403(b) plan is available. Schedule is anticipated to be 4–5 days per week in the administrative offices located in the East Village and includes participation at some evening and weekend events.

Responsibilities:

To set an example as a leader at the organization, responsible for creating positive collaborative relationships within and outside of the organization, managing the Development Associate and Fundraising Intern, and inspiring the staff as a whole

To create a detailed annual fundraising strategy in collaboration with the Executive Director and oversee its implementation and reporting throughout the year

To manage timelines for fundraising activities to ensure strategic plan initiatives and critical fundraising processes are executed in a timely manner

To serve as a liaison to the Board of Trustees and be responsible for keeping them informed and engaged on a number of fronts, including the cultivation of new donors and Board members

To work closely with the Development Associate and Fundraising Intern to maintain and grow the donor base through communication, relationship building, cultivation, and solicitation

To oversee institutional fundraising; manage relationships with corporate, foundation, and government funders; and compose compelling proposals for support

To conceive, plan, and execute critical fundraising eventsa?S—a?Sthe annual gala and the Friends of Movement Research Eventsa?S—a?Sto provide attractive opportunities for connecting donors with our artists and institution

To work with Marketing team to create materials that promote events and donor programs

To keep a close eye on departmental expenses and contributed revenue lines to ensure that annual fundraising goals are met or exceeded
