Finalists of C3 will present a work of their choice at The Ailey Studios on Saturday, June 29, 2019. The selected choreographer will be provided with a creative honorarium, 20 hours of rehearsal with the company during which they will have the opportunity to create and develop new choreographic material on JCP dancers.
