The Dance Program at Bryn Mawr College invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track Assistant Professor position with a terminal degree of an M.F.A. or Ph.D. in Dance to begin August 1, 2022. Our desired colleague is an artist scholar committed to creative, research, and pedagogical practice, and one who will contribute to the development and teaching of a diverse and inclusive undergraduate curriculum and to interdisciplinary programs and college-wide initiatives such as the 360 Program and Emily Balch Seminars. The successful candidate should have a broad perspective on the field of dance and embrace the decolonization of dance by advancing all dance and movement as equitable practices. We welcome multiple genres of contemporary dance practice and performance along with interdisciplinary specializations such as film/screendance, rhythm/soundscaping, improvisation/freestyle, environmental studies, gender studies, community-based/socially-engaged practice, and technology/digital studies.

To apply for this position, candidates must submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, teaching philosophy, research statement, and statement of demonstrated commitment to diversity and inclusion to the Dance Search Committee via Interfolio at: <https://apply.interfolio.com/90022>. In addition, arrange for three letters of recommendation to be submitted via Interfolio to the Dance Search Committee. Applications received by September 20, 2021 will receive full consideration.

Recognizing health and safety concerns during this time, the College will be as flexible as possible in determining the nature of any interviews or meetings (virtual/remote and/or in-person interaction) that are conducted for this search.
