A recent college grad who's struggling with severe anxiety attacks. Introverted and ashamed of being a burden, he's often inarticulate and lacks healthy outlets for his emotions. Fronting a tough, aggressive exterior, he can only be calmed by his close friend, Ellie. He both craves and feels guilty for receiving her care. Nathan ultimately desires freedom from his dark thoughts, but he's terrified by his lack of control, over them.

Lead, Female, 18-26

Ethnicity: Black / African Descent, Ethnically Ambiguous / Multiracial, Latino / Hispanic, Middle Eastern, White / European Descent

A recent college grad who's celebrating her new job. Gentle, kind, and compassionate, she deeply cares for her best friend, Nathan, and knows him better than anyone. A natural caregiver and physically affectionate, Ellie's tenderness keeps him afloat – but his battle with anxiety also takes a toll on her own mental health. While she refuses to abandon him in his time of need, she gives more than she knows how to receive.

Dates:

Shoots March 18th & 19th in NYC metropolitan area.
Choreography rehearsals begin in February, dates TBD.
In-Person Auditions held January 22nd.

Compensation:

\$300/day (3 days total)

Two shoot days, with four choreography rehearsals (3-hours each), billed as an additional shoot day. Talent will receive credit & finished film.

To Submit:

1) DIALOGUE TAPE

Film yourself seated (talking on the phone). Focus on emotion and facial performance.

2) DANCE TAPE

Film a 30-60 second full-body movement improvisation. Be creative! We want an idea of any dance background/intuitions. Feel free to choose any accompanying music that speaks to you. If you can't decide, one of our tonal inspirations is "Love Me Like You Hate Me" by Rainsford.
