Black Dance Change Makers (BDCM) is proud to launch its inaugural Summer Untensive, a two-day liberation lab for Black dancers, cultural workers, and allies who are ready to move, build, and reimagine the dance world—together, in community.

Happening July 26–27, 2025 at *The Joyce New York Center for Creativity & Dance* in Manhattan, the Untensive breaks the mold of traditional dance intensives. Dancers, organizers, and dreamers are invited to experience two days filled with tools, truth, and transformation.

- Movement workshops led by celebrated Black artists
- Political education + skill-building for navigating the dance world—and changing it
- Panels with visionaries who are reshaping the industry from the inside out
- Collective meals + community care (yes, we're feeding you!)

- And the chance to turn your dreams for dance into action
