All work selected for the festival must be 10 minutes (or less) in length. Your video sample must reflect the 10 minutes you wish to perform (no edits).

If selected, you must be available on Friday, March 23 for spacing and lighting and Saturday, March 24, 2012 for the show.

- 1) Name and location of choreographer(s)
- 2) number of performers
- 3) technical needs
- 4) a written proposal/description of work (150 words)
- 5) 10 minute DVD sample of work (rehearsal footage is accepted)
- 6) Application fee: \$15 (checks made out to Elm City Dance Collective, no cash)
