- The number of performers (maximum 4)
- Any special set-up or equipment requirements (it is a low tech event with beautiful day light)

Upon confirmation, you will be asked to pay a rsvp fee of \$30.

### Requirements:

Artists must remain for the duration of the event (3 to 5PM) and it is expected that they will closely follow their colleagues' work and participate in discussions.

No one time use plastic cups or food containers are allowed on the premises.
