Students enhance their enjoyment of dance by learning how to "watch better," to appreciate how a piece is put together, and to recognize choreographic characteristics of different periods and different schools. With a focus on the current season, we attend performances at important dance venues around town. Before each performance, students learn about the program, including the choreographer's and composer's common history.
