This course examines and celebrates the creativity that blossomed all over Europe after World War I. Diaghilev introduced Nijinska, Massine, and—later in the decade—Balanchine to the world. Other companies and radical ideas flourished: Jean Börlin's Ballet Suédois and Oskar Schlemmer's adventures in the Bauhaus era are just a couple examples of the exciting dance world of the 1920s that this course will revisit with the assistance of videos, guest speakers, and a treasure trove of rare archival material.
