Ms. Coates present a preview of *Incarnations*, an evening-length piece that will premiere at Danspace Project in March 2017. Moving between lecture and performance, pedagogy and art, the piece will interweave sources such as Balanchine's 1928 ballet Apollo, the elusive body of Sir Isaac Newton, Stravinsky rehearsing Apollon musagète, the recent discovery of the Higgs boson, and Coates' ongoing collaboration with particle physicist Sarah Demers. The project includes dancers Iréne Hultman, Jon Kinzel, Lacina Coulibaly, and musician-composer Will Orzo. Of Incarnations Deborah Jowitt of The New York Times wrote:
