Black Dancing Bodies, is an intersectional project that captures the knowledge, beauty, and power of Black female street dancers. It seeks to look beyond the traditional lens of exposure for Black bodies in dance, which has overwhelmingly focused on Eurocentric dance aesthetics, including modern, contemporary, and ballet. Launched in 2018, the Black Dancing Bodies Project is an ongoing documentary effort to represent Black women in street and club dance culture.
