She has made work collaboratively with Marya Wethers, Pascale Wettstein, and Abby Crain/Samuel Topiary. She has been in video work of David Bowie, Yanira Castro and Maya Ciarrocchi. Anna has taught through ClassClassClass, Moscow's TSEKH, and University of Texas Pan-American. She is also a yoga teacher. She holds a BFA in Dance from NYU's Tisch School of the Arts. Her first evening length show will be at The Chocolate Factory in February 2017.
